INTRODUCTION

- ❖ DELNET was established in 1988 as city based library network in Delhi, and was popularly known as Delhi Library Network, networking the libraries in Delhi.
- ❖ Got registered as a not-for-profit Society on June 30, 1992.
- ❖ On 13th September 2000, the name of the organization changed from “Delhi Library Network – DELNET” became “DELNET-Developing Library Network”.
- ❖ DELNET with passage of time and technological advancements not only widened its scope but has crossed the geographical boundaries. Presently, it is the major resource sharing library network in India connecting more than 8,797 libraries in 33 States and Union Territories in India and few other countries. It is located in JNU Campus in New Delhi and also has its Units in various parts of India including Bangalore, Pune, Hyderabad and will soon be starting its unit at Lucknow.
- ❖ The main objectives of DELNET is to promote resource sharing among the member-libraries by collecting, storing and disseminating information and by providing networked services to the faculty, students, researchers and scholars, etc to supplement their academic and research activity.
